Vaccination Policy

To insure the protection of all pets under our care, the following vaccinations must be current:

Cats: Rabies & FVRCP-L

Dogs: Rabies, DHLPP, Bordetella, Canine Bivalent Flu

Every animal entering our boarding facility will be given a Capstar tablet for a charge of \$5.00

Medication Administration

Administering medication orally and/or ear and eye drops is available for \$2 per day for dogs and \$3 per day for cats. Administering insulin, changing bandages, wound care, and other special services are charged on a case by case basis.

Medical Illness Policy

One of the advantages of boarding your pet at Lindner Animal Hospital is that veterinary attention is readily available should the need arise. If your pet becomes ill, we will call the emergency number(s) above regarding your pet's symptoms, treatment options, and an estimate of additional costs. If no one can be reached, Lindner Animal Hospital, at its sole discretion, may engage in medical services, treatment, or administration of medications; the expense thereof shall be paid by me prior to my pet leaving.

Discharging Policy

You will always be charged for the day of drop off, no matter what time. Animals will be discharged during normal business hours. If your pet is picked up before noon, you will not be charged for that day. Except on Sunday. Special arrangements may be made to pick up on Sunday from 4:00-5:00, but **prior notification and payments must be made.**
