







### What does the process look like?

#### CONSULTATION

My branding sessions are built based on your specific marketing needs, so it helps for me to know as much about your story and goals as possible while we create your branding plan. We'll start with a phone consultation.

#### **SESSION**

We'll bring your vision to life using the branding plan we created together.

Our session might include real or staged clients on site.

#### **SELECTION**

Images will be uploaded to a password protected gallery for your viewing. Packages are built a la carte, meaning you can purchase as little or as much content as you'd like. You'll choose the images you'd like to license for use from this gallery, and we'll spend about 10–14 days perfecting the chosen photos.

#### **DFIIVERY**

Once your images are publication ready, they'll be delivered in two forms: Full resolution and web optimized. Full resolution photos are printable in high quality at any size. Usage includes brochures, mailers, posters, magazine ads, and even billboards! The web optimized files are processed to load quickly and with extra clarity for use on websites, online ads, and social media platforms.

## How are branding sessions priced?

#### SESSION FEES

This covers time spent on site during the actual photoshoot.

\$300 for up to 2 hours

\$500 for half day

\$800 for full day

#### PHOTO LICENSING

Licensing fees are priced per image. Licenses cover all print and online usage for the purchasing company's marketing needs. Licenses are not shareable or transferrable to other businesses.

\$100 each for 1-9 images

\$90 each for 10-19 images

\$80 each for 20-39 images

\$70 each for 40-79 images

\$60 each for 80+ images

#### **VIDEO**

\$125 equipment fee (hourly or added to a photo session)

\$150 per 10 seconds final footage
