Table II.2a Jump-Off at End—The jump-off for first place for rounds with equal faults if any begins after all competitors have completed their first round.

Table II.2b Jump-Off After Signal—After a clean first round, the competitor will, without leaving the ring, upon an audible signal, commence the designated jump-off course.

Table II.2a/b Jump-Off Option—Each competitor has the option of taking part in the jump-off at the end of their round as in 2(b), or after all competitors have completed the first round as in 2(a).

Table II.2c Power & Speed—After a clean first round, upon crossing the finish line, the competitor will commence the designated jump-off course. Time starts as the horse crosses the finish line for the initial course.

- A. Flattening open from 6:30-7:30 AM Friday, Saturday and Sunday
- B. Ticketed Warm-Up
 - A. Ticketed rounds will not be offered in the Hunter or Opportunity Rings. Hunter and Opportunity rings shall take advantage of the Warm-Up and Low Classes already offered at \$25. **ONE** Ticketed round per horse per day will be permitted in the Jumper Ring.

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

28. PARKING

- A. Will be available in all designated area. No auto parking allowed in the barn area and aisles

MAP & DIRECTION TO FORD IDAHO HORSE PARK

Interstate 184 Westbound from Boise

Take Exit 38 and continue right approximately one-half mile to the traffic light. Continue straight through the traffic light and drive one-quarter mile and turn right into the Ford Idaho Center's parking lot.

Interstate 184 Eastbound from Caldwell and Ontario Oregon

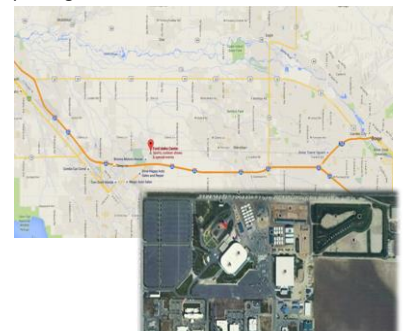
Take Exit 38 and turn left and drive approximately one-half mile to the traffic light. Continue straight through the traffic light and drive one-quarter mile and turn right into the Ford Idaho Center's parking lot

Franklin Road (Meridian, Idaho)

Continue west on Franklin Road past Star Road approximately three quarters of a mile and turn right into the parking lot (entrance past the Service Entry). This parking lot has the most handicapped parking spaces.

State Street (Highway 44), Chinden Boulevard, and Cherry Lane

Continue west past Star Road for one mile and turn left onto Ford Idaho Center Blvd. Continue south (three miles Highway 44, 2 miles Chinden Boulevard, and one-half mile from Cherry Lane.) After crossing the railroad tracks turn left at the second entrance into the main parking lot.
