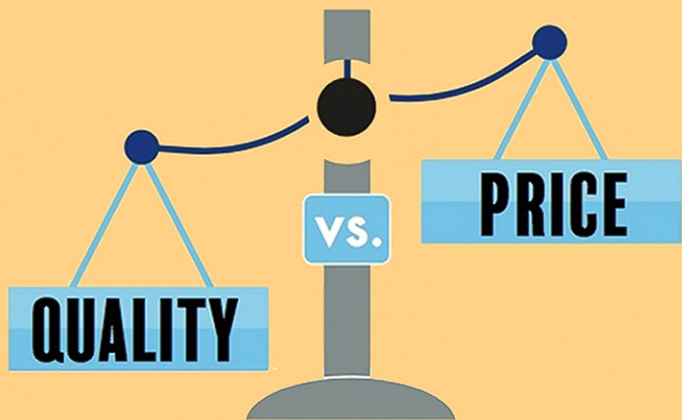


Embarking on the journey of capturing your child or family's precious moments through professional portraiture is an exciting endeavor...

1. FOCUSING SOLELY ON PRICE

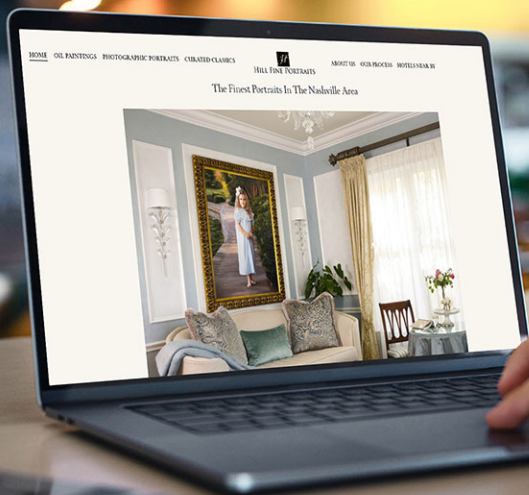


Opting for the cheapest option without considering the quality of the photographer's work or their experience can lead to disappointing results.

4. NOT DISCUSSING EXPECTATIONS AND PREFERENCES



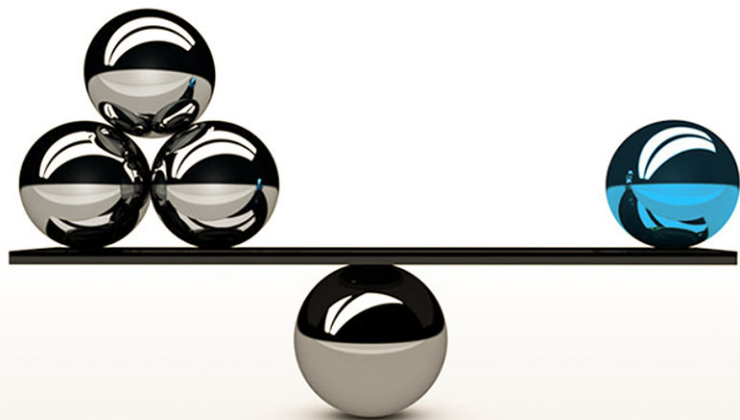
Failing to communicate your preferences, your likes and dislikes or themes, can lead to misunderstandings and disappointment with the final images.
