Pro Tip: Embrace the chaos. Bring extra poop bags and a sense of humor—you'll need both.


2. YOUR SOFA WILL NEVER BE YOURS AGAIN

3. THE "OH NO, NOT AGAIN" MOMENT



They care about one thing: TREATS. You know your dog loves locally sourced, artisanal biscuits. And you oblige with a selection sourced from the best shops in town.


Hot Tip: Always have treats in your pocket. Always. Forget snacks, and you're dead to them.
